

BASINGSTOKE BISON SEASON TICKET APPLICATION INFORMATION 2010/2011 SEASON

Terms and Conditions:

After such a rewarding season in 2009 / 2010 the Basingstoke Bison are pleased to announce that, applications are now invited from those wishing to purchase a season ticket for the 2010 / 2011 ice hockey season.

Ticket categories available are:

- ❖ Adult, Under 16, OAP and Family season tickets.
- ❖ Family season tickets are for 2 adults and 2 children only.
- ❖ Please note that there is no student season ticket available.

Season tickets will cover 28 competitive home games of the Basingstoke Bison excluding all Playoff games and cup semi final and final games.

The exact mix of league, cup and challenge games will be clarified once the number of teams and competition structure has been confirmed for the 2010/11 season.

There are a number of fantastic benefits associated with being a season ticket holder including:-

- ❖ The lowest possible admission prices for Bison games.
 - ❖ Your personal seat reserved for you for non season ticket games to enable you to purchase your seats at your leisure up to 90 minutes before face off.
 - ❖ Five lucky season ticket holders have their season tickets personally delivered to them by a Bison player at the start of the season.
 - ❖ An invitation to watch an exclusive Bison training session at the Basingstoke Arena and enjoy seeing the team put through their paces by Steve Moria, Bison Player Coach.
 - ❖ An invitation to an exclusive 'Skate with the Bison' session, where for one hour it will be just season ticketholders and Bison players on the ice.

- Season tickets can be paid for in one or three instalments as detailed on the prices and payment options sheet.
 - For those people paying by credit card an administration surcharge of £1 will be charged on all transactions and for those paying by 3 instalments there will be a £3 charge payable for using a credit or debit cards to pay for season tickets.
 - Normal admission prices will apply for all games not covered by a season ticket but for all those games, season ticket holders will have their seats reserved for them until 90 minutes before face off. We do, however, reserve the right to vary this time period from time to time.
 - Season tickets will be transferable in that they can be used by someone else of the same category. Standing tickets are available but there is no further reduction in price.
 - Season tickets can not be booked in Blocks G, H, I & J (Schools & Group blocks) & Blocks N, O, P & Q (reserved for Away supporters).
 - There will be a charge of £20 to replace any lost tickets.

- We will make every effort to place your application as close as possible to the seats you request on your form but if there is any difficulty we will contact you to discuss so please ensure that you include your email address and / or phone number on the application form.
- Existing season ticket holders have priority on renewing their existing seats until Friday 11th June 2010, thereafter all unreserved seats will be released and will be available on a first come, first served basis.
- Any seat not currently held by a season ticket holder can be purchased immediately.

- Please note that we are unable to reserve seats ahead of receiving an application form and payment.
- Child tickets require the applicant to be Under 16 years of age and OAP tickets require the applicant to be over 60 years of age on 1st September 2010. PROOF OF AGE WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL CONCESSION APPLICATIONS, EVEN IF PREVIOUSLY PROVIDED.

In applying for a season ticket, you recognise and accept that Basingstoke Bison have the right to :-

- ❖ Offer special promotions during the course of the season, which may or may not alter the relative value of the season ticket.
- ❖ Remove any section of seating from use at any time, for any reason, without penalty
- ❖ Reschedule season ticket games or substitute alternative fixtures

- Season tickets are on sale NOW to new applicants and existing season ticket holders.
- Current season ticket holders have until Friday 11th June 2010 to renew their current seats.
- To qualify for the early bird price, you must have booked and paid in full or the first instalment by Friday 11th June 2010.
